New Life Children's Home Translator: "I am 18 year old Korean girl serving the New Life Children's Home in Soonchun. I read the letter that come from America and write the English letters for the children to you. I am in 3rd grade of senior High Mission School. I am self supporting student. I haven't a father and my mother is blind. I have no brother or sister. My mother cannot anything. I am poor and very lonely. I am a S. School teacher and I love Jesus very much."
