Dear Sunday School Superintendent:

Have you ever been really driven to your knees to pour out your heart to God for His special divine help? I'm sure you have. This is what has happened to me during the last few days. I must tell you about it.

Within the last few days I have received in the mail from Korea well over two hundred pictures and case histories of new orphans! Many of these dear children are from our present orphanages that have recently been taken in off the streets. Many are in new orphanages we have promised to help. But never have we had any large number like this at one time. We, here at our office, were just overwhelmed when they all piled up. But we went to prayer about finding sponsors for all these new children. God seemed to say to me that He had sent them to our Homes that they might hear the blessed Gospel and be saved from sin, that we might provide for their daily needs and train them to be His servants in future years. Also that He had His people across America, Canada and other lands who would be glad to help if they only knew about this blessed work and the wonderful joy it brings to the child as well as the sponsor.

Many Conference Baptist Sunday Schools, departments and classes (many other fine denominational groups too) are sponsoring one of our orphans and write us of what a great blessing it has been to them. They have sent parcels to the child and gotten back "thank you" letters and pictures showing him with the clothing on and his face beaming. The letters have been read and the pictures mounted on the bulletin board. These Sunday Schools have been amazed how the funds come in for the orphan's support each month, proving that people WANT to give and are blessed and happy in doing it!

I have selected twelve children of various ages and have enclosed their pictures and a few facts about their lives. These children are not sponsored, but very much need sponsors so we can support them and not send them back on to the streets to beg and steal. They are typical of all the others. Their ages are such that they would appeal to the various departmental groups and classes. We will gladly send a negative so that prints can be made for a whole class or department.

Because of this desperate present need, I ask you, yes, I plead with you, please help us help these dear children--for Christ sake. Look over these pictures and read their stories. Then prayerfully present it for action. Tell them of the simple plan of supporting them for only \$8.00 a month. Tell them too, that they will receive his picture, his case history, the orphanage picture with the whole group, mailing instructions and full particulars. Tell them how rich we are in America and what a wonderful opportunity this is. When they have made their selection, have them fill out the form with the child's number and mail it right away to me. Perhaps you, yourself, would like to sponsor a child. Now I have unburdened my heart to you. God bless you as you seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit in this matter.
