My Dear Friends:

Have you ever been really driven to your knees to pour out your heart to God for His special divine help? I'm sure you have. This is what has happened to me during the last few days. I must tell you about it.

Within the last few days I have received in the mail from Korea well over **two hundred pictures** and case histories of new orphans! Many of these dear children are from our present orphanages that have recently been taken in off the streets. Many are in new orphanages we have promised to help. But **never** have we had any large number like this at one time. We, here at our office, were just overwhelmed when they all piled up. But we went to prayer about finding sponsors for all these new children. God seemed to say to me that He had sent them to our Homes that they might hear the blessed gospel and be saved from sin, that we might provide for their daily needs and train them to be His servants in future years. Also that He had His people across America, Canada and other lands, who would be glad to help if they only knew about this blessed work and the wonderful joy it brings to the child as well as the sponsor.

I know that through my personal efforts it would take a long time to obtain so many new sponsors. That's why I need your help! If many hundreds of you, my dear friends, will earnestly seek to interest some friend, relative, S. S. class, Women's group, etc., I know we can have enough new sponsors in a very short time so that we can care for all these dear children and perhaps more!

I have selected twelve children of various ages and have enclosed their pictures and a few facts about their lives. These children are not sponsored, but very much need sponsors so we can support them and not send them back on to the streets to beg and steal. They are very typical of all the others.

Now I ask you, yes, I plead with you, please help us. Will you take the pictures and show them to your friends? Tell them of the simple plan of supporting them for only \$8 a month. Tell them, too, that they will receive his picture, case history, mailing instructions and full particulars. Tell them how rich we are in America and what a wonderful opportunity this is. When they have made their selection, have them fill out the form with the child's number and mail it right away.

I'm sure that many who get this letter will want to sponsor a child also. If you are already a sponsor, perhaps you could sponsor another.

Now I have unburdened my heart to you. God bless you as you seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit in this matter.

## SHORT CASE HISTORY OF THESE CHILDREN

- 20** Cho Hwa Ja is nine years old. Her father died several years ago. Her mother disappeared. She is very cheerful, is in the first grade (just started school). Her ten year old brother is also in this orphanage. Perhaps someone would like to sponsor them both.
- 21** Paek Yung Sook is about seven years old. She does not know anything about her parents. The Orphanage Superintendent found her wandering on the streets. She loves to sing and is in first grade.
- 22** Kim Yung Shik is eight years old. His father was killed in action in the Korean war. Later the mother died too. He stayed with neighbors for a time but was found wandering on the streets. He is in first grade. No. 25 below is his brother.
- 23** Jung Koo Shik is twelve years old. His mother was killed by the Communists and his father died of disease in 1955. He lived with an older brother until he enlisted in the army. He was led by a staff member to the orphanage. He is doing excellent work in 4th grade. His brother is No. 24 below.
- 24** Jung Moo Choon is fourteen years old and doing very well in 7th grade. He is a brother of No. 23 above.
- 25** Kim Yung Chul is ten years old. He and his grandmother begged from door to door until he came into the orphanage. He is doing well in the 2nd grade. His brother is No. 22 above.
- 26** Jung Choon Ja is five years old, born on Christmas Day! After her father died in 1957 her mother disappeared. She was found begging for food by a policeman who brought her to the home. She is weak from malnutrition but is slowly gaining strength.
- 27** Ki Shung Suh is fifteen years old and in ninth grade. His father, who was a medical doctor, died while fleeing from the Communists. He lost his mother along the way. When his grandmother could no longer feed him, a mail-man brought him to the orphanage. His favorite subject in school is mathematics.
- 28** Son Jong Ok is nine years old and in first grade (just started). His father was killed by the Communists and his mother's whereabouts is unknown. He has a calm and gentle disposition.
- 29** Chang Haeng Sook is nearly thirteen years old and already in ninth grade. She is a good student, loves singing and the English language. Both of her parents died during the Korean war. She was wandering from place to place before coming into the orphanage.
- 30** Kang Myung Ok is three years old, very healthy and happy! Her father died on the front lines in 1956. While begging with her two children, her mother found this orphanage and now lives and works there. Her brother is five years old.
- 31** Kim Shin Ja is ten years old. Her father, a farmer, died during the Korean war and her mother disappeared. The county office brought her to the orphanage. She is doing well in the fourth grade.
