Many of you have responded to our Blanket Appeal and we have been so glad. Recently one of the workers in the Chicago CARE office called me to say how thrilled they were about this whole project, and also the head office in New York is very pleased. Many have ordered one or more blankets for their own orphan, and others for all in general. Many, many thanks. You who have forgotten, or neglected to do so, please send in your order to CARE or, if you prefer, directly to our office. (Remember to use our new address above.)


Earlier this Summer I sent you 12 pictures and case histories of new orphans, asking you to help us find new sponsors. Many of you did wonderfully well. We got scores of new sponsors. But since then we have taken into our 28 Homes in Korea many more children off the streets. Also we have crying appeals from about 10 other Orphanages that are not able to feed or care for their many, many children on the small grain ration given them by the Korean government. They have no money for clothing, shoes, underwear, mittens, caps, school tuition, books and supplies. They have no help from anyone.

So, as I have prayed about this, I felt that I should come to you for help again in the same way. We have chosen 12 more children and you will find a short case history about each one on the back of this letter. Please show these to your friends, your church groups, etc., asking them if they will sponsor one of them. It will be such a blessing to the sponsors as so many hundreds know, to say nothing of what it will mean to the homeless children. Cold weather is coming soon in Korea. We must act as soon as possible. Tell your friends of our simple plan of supporting each child for only \$8 a month. Tell them, too, that they will receive each child's picture, story, address, mailing instructions and full particulars. Help them fill out the form and mail it to us with the number of the child selected.

I am asking God to give us 500 new sponsors by Christmas time! Will you join with us in this prayer, and in our earnest effort to obtain that many? Just think what that would mean for the Kingdom of God! Each child will be brought to Christ and trained to serve Him.

Again I have unburdened my heart to you. May God use you as His instrument.

## SHORT CASE HISTORY OF THESE CHILDREN

- 32** Kim Jung Ja is ten years old and can smile because Christ comforts her heart. But her father was kidnapped by the Communists and our bombers killed her mother! The neighbors took her with them as they fled South. (She was a baby one year old.) She is in third grade now and loves to sing.
- 33** Lee Chung Woon lost both parents in the war not long after he was born. He stayed in another Home for a short time, but now is in our Garden of Eden Orphanage. He is in second grade, average in his studies. Now he wants an American Daddy and Mommie.
- 34** Lee In Sup was born about June 1, 1954. He was a foundling baby, his parents are completely unknown. The Pusan Social Welfare Section brought him to the Orphanage. He is very healthy and cheerful.
- 35** Kim Yung Ok means "a lovely girl." Although less than three years old at the time, she was found begging from door to door by the superintendent of the Orphanage. She is now 4½ years old and longs for a Canadian Daddy and Mommie.
- 36** Pak Won Chun was found crying by his neighbors when he was less than two years old. Both his parents had vanished, abandoning him! He is now five years old and a fine boy.
- 37** Kim Tae Bok was nine years old on June 16th. He does not know who or where his father is. His mother works for other people, but earns no money to care for him. He looks like he is "all boy"!
- 38** Yoon Soon Ok is not quite five years old. Her father died two years ago. The mother being unable to feed her remarried and disappeared! When relatives could not care for her longer, they brought her to our Home. She's a darling.
- 39** Kim Sung Kwon was begging for food when he found our Orphanage and was taken in. His mother died in 1958. His father, a disabled laborer, now begs for a living. Kim is 3½ years old.
- 40** Bong Mi Hae will be three years old on November 14th. She was born in Seoul, but no one knows what happened to her father. Her mother died after childbirth in 1957. She really is a very sweet child but was afraid of the camera.
- 41** Kim Sook Ee's father was killed in action before she was born. (She was born July 24, 1951.) Her mother later died of disease. After being in the Pusan Babies' Home for a time she was brought to the Eden Orphanage. She is in second grade. A gentle girl.
- 42** Lee Man Shik has two brothers who also sorrow for a Mommie and Daddy. This boy, with a calm nature, is 3½ years old. After his parents disappeared neighbors brought him to our Orphanage. He is very healthy.
- 43** Lee Bok Hui. It is hard to believe in America and Canada that, though less than three years old, this child was found begging for food. Nothing is known of her parents. Her name means "a blessed child."
