We've finished roofing our new church with thatch. At present, our meeting-house is shabby just like the log-house of Abraham Lincoln and it is small for our congregation. But we are glad to think that we will be able to have a new wonderful new meeting-house soon. Since we entered this new year, we selected newly 7 deacons, 4 deaconesses, and 14 S.S. teachers. I believe they will serve our church eagerly during this new year. And 17 choir members will help our service as their Hymns.

Mr. Byun Soo Jo and his wife who had been won to the Lord in October, are in despair. Because their third son suddenly died of illness. So I often visit them to comfort with His words. In January, two young men (Mr. Lee Yung Soo and Mr. Hwang Koo Yun) joined the military service. They have served our church eagerly. We miss them very much. Mr. Jo Tae Yong who made a decision to believe in Christ in September, is attending church regularly, but his friends (Miss Pak Seung Sil and Miss Huh Hyun Joo) do not attend church regularly.

From the 3rd Sunday of January, we started having a prayer-meeting with some American soldiers who are stationed near our church. Every Sunday, for 30 minutes from 3 o'clock, P.M., Mr. Thompson will lead our prayer-meeting.
