

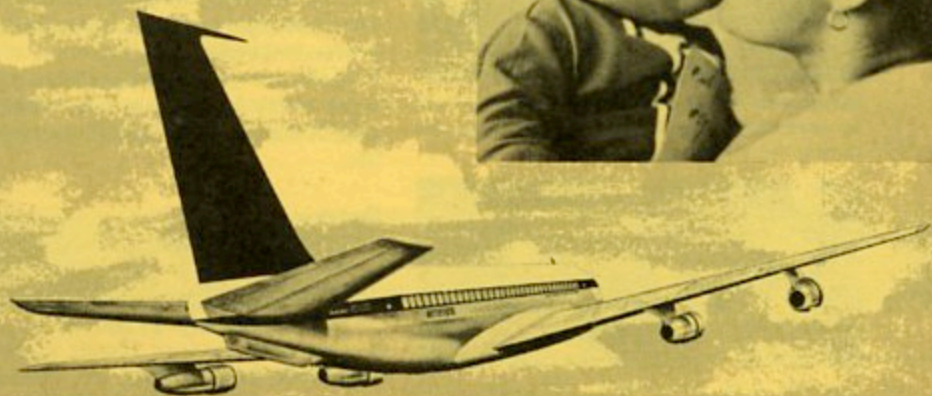

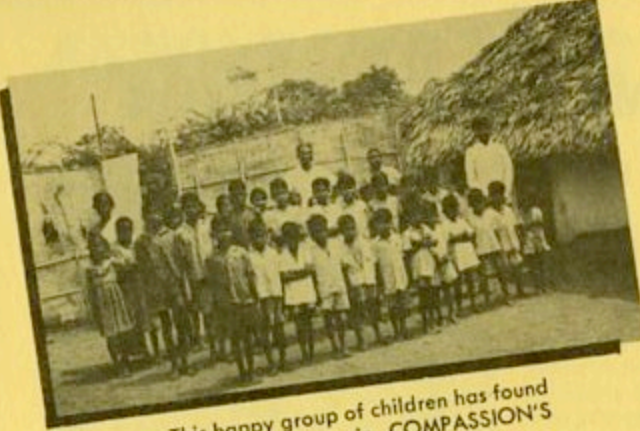

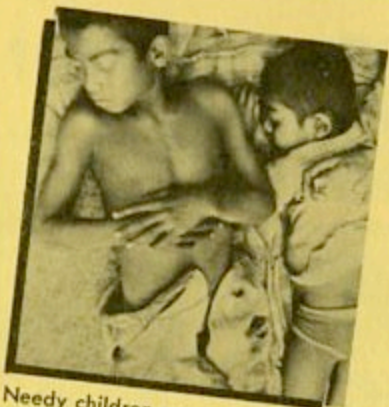

Merry Christmas FOR A LONELY CHILD



Hurry! Hurry! Hurry! This may be your last chance to bring joy, happiness and love to a lonely child this Christmas. Yes, if you do not provide a gift for your own child (or one of more unsponsored children) soon, it will be too late for your gift to reach the field before Christmas.

The best way to assure a gift for your child, especially if you have not yet sent it, is by forwarding a money gift to COMPASSION'S Chicago office. In turn, we will give you credit for the gift and forward it without delay to the field. Then, the superintendent or field worker will purchase an appropriate gift for child. On Christmas morning the gift will be given to the child with an explanation that you are the sender.

When you forward your gift to the Chicago office you may specify what you would like the superintendent or field worker to purchase. Your request will be followed as much as possible. Of course, you should send a moderately small amount—not in excess of \$5.00 for each child.

It is possible for sponsors to send packages direct to their children in Korea, but this must be done at the sponsor's risk, since the mails are not fully reliable in other lands. All parcels for children in Korea should be addressed as follows:

If you sponsor a child in a land other than Korea it is not possible at this time to send packages direct to the child. Customs restrictions and other factors are not such that packages can be handled at this time. In these cases the only way to provide a gift is by forwarding your money gift to Chicago for transmittal to the field, where a gift will be purchased for your child.
