Five Thousand Reached for Christ

During a recent visit to Korea, Compassion's President, Henry Harvey, made arrangements with the Reverend Jack Baskin, Baptist Bible Fellowship missionary to Korea, to conduct evangelistic meetings in scores of Compassion Homes. Teams were organized, and during the summer meetings were held in COMPASSION Homes throughout Korea. The following letter from Reverend Baskin to Henry Harvey describes the results of these meetings.

Dear Brother Harvey:

Many times I have recalled the blessed experiences we had fellowshiping together. Especially I remember the trip we took to the Island. But more than all I recall our last meeting at the airport when we vowed to pray for each other. I have prayed for you but not as much as you deserve in the great work you are doing.

Briefly I want to tell you of the great number of blessings our teams received while visiting your orphanages. As yet we do not fully know the count of conversions, but well over 5,000 publicly confessed Christ as Lord and Saviour for the first time. Many hundreds have written testimonies to our teachers. Orphanage directors, staff workers, and even preachers were saved. They literally begged our teams to either remain longer or come again. Sins were openly confessed and repented of. Staff workers said they never dreamed that salvation could be so simply explained.

Among those saved was this one exceptional testimony I want to give you. Three handicapped girls had conspired to commit suicide. They listened to the message of hope and all three came to Christ for new hope and a new lease on life. These and many other testimonies will be available to you after translation. . . . I am looking forward to seeing you . . . when you return.
