Dear Christian Friend(s):

WINTER IS COMING IN KOREA! Yes, in mid-summer we must think and plan for winter, especially when considering Korea, eight thousand miles away. Many of our Homes have no provision for heating whatever. They do not use stoves at all in Korea. Some of these have "hot floors" made of clay. It gets below zero in South Korea and my heart goes out to these dear children. They huddle together, so many in a small room to help keep each other warm that TB is easily transmitted. None of them have any beds but all sleep on the floors.

Recently I sent a questionnaire to our 28 Homes asking about present supplies of blankets and next winter's needs. We found an appalling need! Our superintendents requested a total of 5757 blankets!! (for over 2500 people who sleep ON and UNDER them). At the very low CARE cost of \$3 each, they would still cost us \$17,271.00! Of course we have no funds like this.

After prayerful consideration, we have decided to "stick our necks out" BY FAITH and have ordered a total of 2395 blankets, costing \$7185.00. We have less than \$1000.00 of this now in our "blanket fund," but 2395 blankets are not nearly enough!

So I have three requests. First, that every orphan sponsor send at least one blanket to your child. Through CARE it will cost only \$3 for a 90% reprocessed 60 x 80 3 pound blanket delivered to the child. Delivery is guaranteed with no import duty charged. Your gifts are tax deductible. Some could send several. (Some older sponsors on social security may not be able to send any.)

Secondly, our many friends who are not sponsors, but help from time to time, can help too. I believe there are some who would like to send 100 blankets, or 50, 40, 30, 20, 10, 5 or 2. There are two ways you non-sponsors can do this: you can mail the enclosed envelope to CARE designating the blankets to EVERETT SWANSON, PRESBYTERIAN MISSION, 1 NAM SAN DONG, TAEGU, KOREA and missionary friends will distribute them to nearby Homes. (We have 13 Homes in the Taegu area.) Or, a better way for more equitable distribution to far-away Homes, is to send your funds to our office and we will order the blankets from CARE in YOUR name to be sent directly to the orphanage that especially needs them. You will get a thank-you letter directly from the Home with a picture of the blankets and the children made happy by them!

Thirdly, we need help to pay the \$7185.00 we must pay for the 2395 blankets we have already ordered. Designate your gifts as "Blanket Fund" and they will pay for blankets at the rate of \$3 each. Whatever you do, please act promptly because it takes time to process, order, ship and deliver the blankets to the Homes. Do it today!

NOW, ANOTHER THING. It is very important that Christmas parcels be mailed VERY early. We STRONGLY urge you to mail them NOT LATER than OCTOBER FIRST. So many were disappointed last year because their gifts did not arrive until after Christmas—in some cases many weeks later! Avoid the awful rush of Christmas mail.

Please read and keep the enclosed card announcing our new mailing address. Notice that it is effective September first.

FINALLY, I'm thinking about the many homeless children in Korea who not only have no blankets for winter, but have no homes whatever. What will winter do to them? We are taking in more children every month as we get more sponsors to support them. We still can fully care for them for a full month for only \$8. Will you sponsor one, or perhaps another one? Will you bring this wonderful opportunity to save souls to the attention of some group in your church? God will reward you richly. God bless you.
