Dear Native Missionary Supporter:

We have now received some of the pictures and information covering the Korean native workers, which we enclose here. Some of them are already engaged in work, others are soon to begin. Some are young, others more mature. Some are men, some are women. ALL are deeply consecrated and zealous for the Lord, and bringing Christ to their own people. Some have given us more information about themselves, their past, their present work, etc. than others. You will obtain much more as you write back and forth.

Now about writing: Always use AIRMAIL. YOU are expected to write the first letter, introducing yourself as supporter and prayer warrior. A snap shot of yourself will be deeply appreciated. Ask questions. Avoid telling about American luxuries. Major on spiritual things. Allow time for a reply. On their very small salary, they may use boat mail, which could take 6 weeks, although usually less time.

Please completely disregard any address you see on the personal information of your worker. Use this one only: c/o CHRISTIAN REVIVAL FELLOWSHIP, 5 NAM SAN DONG, TAEJU, KOREA. Please PRINT his name and number very clearly above this address. Also PRINT your return address. You may send parcels directly to him. Extra cash gifts must be sent through our office.

Arrangements have been made for periodic reports to be sent. It will take time; after the first month's work is done, then sent to Taegu for translation and mailed. Please be patient! Remember we are doing all this book work, correspondence, translation, postage, etc., FREE. ALL of your \$10 goes to the native worker!

Remember we must send the support a full month ahead. (Example: support for March is sent to Korea on February 1st.) Please try to be prompt. We have paid some men for two or three months already.

Again, thank you and God bless you for this partnership we have in getting out the Gospel to these dear people. Daily prayer is needed. To God be all the glory for what will be accomplished. We expect much fruit. You will rejoice to know that we will probably have over 80 workers supported instead of the original 20! Praise God.
