Dear Orphan Sponsor:

I am enclosing a picture of "your adopted orphan" in the Good Samaritan Children's Home near Taegu, Korea. After prayerful thought, I have assigned this child to you as you have requested. Since we have many times more boys than girls, it has been necessary to substitute a boy for a girl in some cases. Because it is now several years since the end of the war, we now have quite a few teen agers. Some of these have been wandering aimlessly all this time over Korea, just begging for an existence. It is amazing that they have survived at all! But their conversion to Christ is absolutely wonderful, for HE means EVERYTHING to them after such a life. After reading "thank you" letters to their sponsors this week from 2 of our oldest boys who were just inducted into the Korean army, my eyes filled with tears and I found myself saying out loud "Well, praise God, it has been worth it all". Their former sponsors will cherish those letters a long time and follow them with their prayers.

Let me tell you about this Home. It has been operating for some time under the name of "Number 2 Boys Shelter" and was dependent upon American GI support. When the Americans moved out, it became desperate for funds for support. Money was borrowed until they were in debt nearly the whole value of the property. Even with the coldest winter in 30 years, they could not replace many broken windows! It was about to be sold to an ungodly organization. Then we stepped in and purchased it for \$6500! There are 139 boys and 25 girls now being cared for. We felt this was a tremendous evangelistic opportunity, not just to win these to Christ, but to train them to be Christian leaders in Korea tomorrow!

Every member of the staff is a true Christian. School classes are taught right in our building by competent teachers. Much Bible is given. There are 30-40 adult believers meeting here each Sunday, with all the children, and soon we expect to have a church organized and self supporting.

By all means write to your orphan soon. Send a parcel from time to time. You will be thrilled to get an answer. You can hardly imagine the child's joy. Follow the enclosed instructions. Here is the address:

Please send your support money a month in advance if possible, for we must mail it that much ahead of time. Also, please help us get new sponsors. We need them even for our present children, and there are still thousands of homeless children on the streets. Thank you for your love and compassion for these dear ones. We now have 12 Homes in Korea with about 800 orphans, leper's children, and widows supported, and about 700 more being helped.

When you write to or about the child, always use the number and name. If you would like to make more prints, write for a returnable negative.
