Dear Praying Friend:

Another tremendous opportunity has come to me, which after long prayer and deliberation, I believe to be God's call beyond a doubt. Korean Missionaries and National leaders have been writing repeatedly for a year urging me to come for another great evangelistic tour, (My 4th one) A few weeks ago I consented to give ten weeks of time, April 10th to June 15th for several area wide evangelistic campaigns.

Plans are well along for the campaigns in Yosu, Pusan, Chin Hae, Kumchan, Andong, Seoul, Samchok, and Myongju. I will be giving some time to the Korean armed forces in their Military Academies, as well as up on the front lines near the 38th parallel. Student meetings will include high schools, colleges and chosen Christian Universities.

You can see what a great challenge and opportunity this presents! I am not equal to it. How I need your prayers! In our previous services in Korea we have seen about 45,000 people profess faith in Christ! Will you pray for many thousands more this time? A Korean minister writes, "The Lord's highest voltage of the Almighty Power be with you for your great spiritual revival meetings". Amen! This is what we all need.

Rev. Robert Rice, outstanding missionary in Korea, writes: "The time is short over here, and we may not have even months to labor for the Lord". The Reds in North Korea have built up tremendous forces and modern equipment to strike again at South Korea. Col. Ben C. Limb, permanent ROK representative at the U.N. says, "As a result of the truce violation by the Communists, an extremely explosive situation exists in Korea". So you see, it is imperative that we do all we can NOW to win souls in Korea.

This series of campaigns will cost money, several thousand dollars, for travel, equipment, advertizing, film, etc. I know that you want to do more than pray, by helping meet the financial need. I am trusting God. Some can very little I know, but others whom the Lord has blessed and prospered, could easily send \$100, \$500 or even more. Large or small, it will be deeply appreciated, carefully expended and wisely invested in the salvation of souls! May I hear from you as soon as possible? "THIS WEEK marked the first anniversary of our Home's existence as a Christian Orphanage, and so the staff decided to have a birthday party for all the orphans as well. The Board of Directors were also invited and entertained. When I recall the bedraggled group of children which I surveyed there last autumn, and make comparisons with the well dressed, healthy and happy multitude that celebrated this week-- God be praised for a modern miracle! Two young ladies are volunteering their services in teaching a Bible Club (Christ-centered day school) which includes not only the orphans not yet enrolled in the public school, but also a considerable number from the nearby village who otherwise would have no opportunity of schooling. In this way the Christian witness of the Home is being enlarged to reach out to the neighboring communities, as many from non-believing homes come to the orphanage for daily instruction. The playground equipment, made possible by your recent gift, is in operation, and much appreciated. The spiritual growth at the Home is just as encouraging as the material blessing for which you have been largely responsible in recent months. Mr. Pak told me that all the children have now professed their faith in our Lord and are joining enthusiastically in the religious activities of each day. It's impossible to describe in words the spirit of hope and Christian dedication that impresses one there today. Sincere thanks for the gift of the sewing machine too.
